Où part-il / part-elle généralement pendant les vacances ? Il / Elle va...

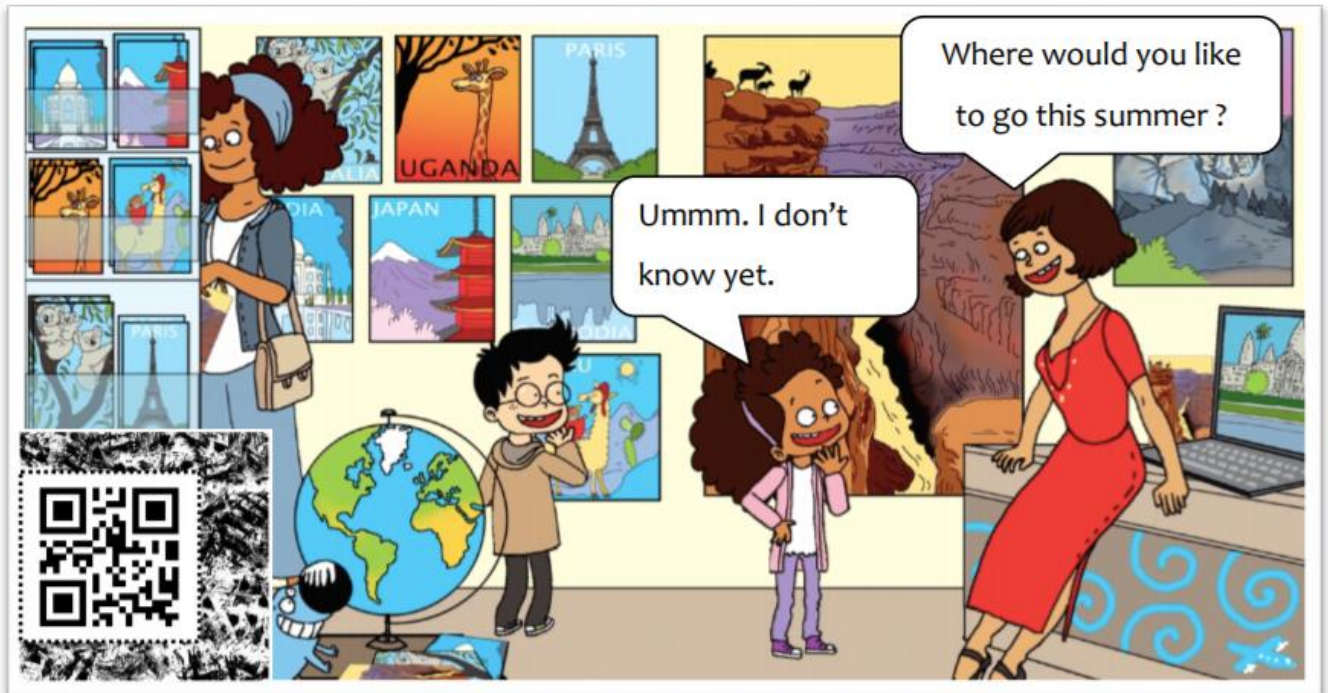
Comment te rends-tu à la campagne ?
